**1. Operational Programmes Employment and Social Inclusion and Education, 2007 - 2013 - Slovakia**

Context indicators were established at Programme level for both Operational Programmes related to Human Development, namely: *Operational Programme – Employment and Social Inclusion* (Ministry of Labour, Social Affairs and Family of the Slovak Republic) and *Operational Programme Education* (Ministry of Education of the Slovak Republic). In the table below we present the context indicators established for both programmes and as presented in the two OPs:

<b>Poverty Risk Rate</b> - Share of persons with equivalent available income less than 60% of the median of the national equivalent income classified pursuant to age (0-15; 16+;16-64; 65+) and gender (anchored in 2004)	%	Operational Programme – Employment and Social Inclusion
<b>Gender Wage Difference in Unmodified Form</b> - Difference of average gross income per hour between men and women.	%	Operational Programme – Employment and Social Inclusion

<b>Graduates from the tertiary level of higher education</b> - No. of graduates from the tertiary level of higher education (doctorands) in 1000 aged 20 – 29	No	Operational Programme Education
<b>Youth with secondary education</b> - Population percentage aged 20 – 24 which has achieved at least secondary education or completed post-maturita studies (EU benchmark)	%	Operational Programme Education
<b>Population percentage (aged 18 – 24) with lower secondary education, not receiving any further education</b> - Population percentage (aged 18 – 24) with lower secondary education, not receiving any further education – early school leavers (EU benchmark)	%	Operational Programme Education
